



General Club Rules

In order to ensure that all members have an enjoyable experience at Zambesi Tennis Club, the club committee approved general club rules to regulate the use of the club facilities:

1. The clubhouse and the patio is a Smoke Free Area.
2. Please assist in keeping the clubhouse, toilets and grounds tidy. Take care of your own litter by using the trash bins provided.
3. Safety is everyone's concern and responsibility. When you leave the club, kindly ensure that the front gate has been closed before leaving in order to ensure that entry to the grounds is restricted.
4. When you play tennis during the week, kindly ensure that the court is locked before you leave.
5. When you have played under the floodlights, please ensure that, if you are last to leave, the gate to the toilets and light box is locked.
6. Players have to wear acceptable tennis attire at all times. Tennis shoes, cross trainers or running shoes are permitted, provided that they do not leave marks on the court.
7. Chewing gum, alcohol or cigarettes are not permitted on court.
8. The club committee may contract a TSA registered coach to use the club's courts for tennis coaching on certain terms and conditions as stipulated in the contract.
9. Members are entitled to have a maximum of 3 visitor joining them for social tennis during the week. Visitors have to pay a visitor's fee of R20 per person. Only one court per member may be booked in a single time slot.
10. All visitors who participate on Saturday afternoons have to pay a visitor's fee of R20.
11. The courts are leased for the benefit of club members. Non-members are only allowed to play on a court if a member plays with them on the same court.

12. Courts are permanently locked with a combination lock and the combination is provided to all club members whose club fees are payed up to date. A "WhatsApp" group is created for this purpose.
13. When utilising the lounge area inside the clubhouse, please do not place your feet on the chairs or the tables.
14. Social play on Saturdays will be coordinated by at least one committee member.
15. Access to the kitchen behind the counter is only available to committee members.
