



General Club Rules

In order to ensure that all members have an enjoyable experience at Zambesi Tennis Club, the club committee approved general club rules to regulate the use of the club facilities:

1. The clubhouse and the patio is a Smoke Free Area.
2. Please assist in keeping the clubhouse, toilets and grounds tidy. Take care of your own litter by using the trash bins provided.
3. Safety is everyone's concern and responsibility. When you leave the club, kindly ensure that the front gate has been closed before leaving in order to ensure that entry to the grounds is restricted.
4. All members are required to book courts on-line using the SportyHQ bookings application. Refer to the club's website for more information regarding court bookings. A small donation of R10 per player per session can be paid to the person unlocking the courts to help fund this initiative.
5. When you want to play under the floodlights, please arrange this with Jaco Visser, who will advise the procedure to follow. The floodlights work with "pre-paid" electricity tokens.
6. Players have to wear acceptable tennis attire at all times. Tennis shoes, cross trainers or running shoes are permitted, provided that they do not leave marks on the court.
7. Chewing gum, alcohol or cigarettes are not permitted on court.
8. The club committee may contract a TSA registered coach to use the club's courts for tennis coaching on certain terms and conditions as stipulated in the contract.

9. Members are entitled to have a maximum of 3 visitor joining them for social tennis during the week. Visitors have to pay a visitor's fee of R50 per person. Only one court per member may be booked in a single time slot.
 10. All visitors who participate on Saturday afternoons have to pay a visitor's fee of R50.
 11. The courts are leased for the benefit of club members. Non-members are only allowed to play on a court if a member plays with them on the same court.
 12. Courts are permanently locked and will only be unlocked when a on-line booking was made.
 13. When utilising the lounge area inside the clubhouse, please do not place your feet on the chairs or the tables.
 14. Social play on Saturdays and Wednesdays will be coordinated by at least one committee member.
 15. Access to the kitchen behind the counter is only available to committee members.
 16. Court bookings can be made using the mobile application provided by SportyHQ or via their website.
Courts are available for booking as follows:
08h00 to 20h00 - Monday to Friday
11h00 to 18:30 - Sundays
- The booking system will show you when a court is not available or has already been booked.
